• Shot Schedule Templates

Manage your patients' shots more efficiently with defined individualized template shot schedules; track build-up and maintenance shots; modify patient shot schedules as needed and follow up with patients who have late or missed shots via email and letter templates

• Shot Template Based Skin Test

Quickly document skin test results when defining antigens, allergens, histamines, and diluents from a single screen. Easily record skin tests using wheal and flare or scores with access of previous test results.

• Vial Management

Manage and track your vials with bar-coded labels for improved patient safety. Quickly create vials with different dilutions for desired concentrations and create lot numbers for tracking of diluents and antigens as well as inventory management.

• Generate Recipes From Skin Test Results

Allows allergists to populate recipes based on skin test results while linking antigens with skin test allergens, creating multiple recipes from one skin test and minimizing recipe errors.

• Shot Module

Enhance patient safety and improve efficiency by documenting pre and post-injection questionnaires. Patient safety will be ensured with bar-coded vials; automated patient shot schedules; validations and warnings for expired vials and/or early or late shot administrations and useful reminders for future tasks and color-coded shot histories.

Why a Certified EHR?

To ensure that the system you select will allow you to qualify for Meaningful Use federal incentive payments, select a solution that is EHR Certified. Since there are few benchmark measures available to provide a level of confidence regarding specific EHR functions an EHR certification is very important.

The ONC-ATCB certification has been developed by the federal government to certify that an EHR system meets the technical requirements needed for a provider to become a meaningful user of an EHR system. The use of an ONC-ATCB certified product is required to receive any federal government incentive money for the use of an EHR system. The ONC-ATCB certification test script is very specific to EHR criteria that qualified providers must meet in order to participate in the government incentive program. There are two types of ONC-ATCB certifications; one for Complete EHRs and one for EHR Modules. A Complete EHR certification for Stage 1 Meaningful Use means that the EHR product has met all 33 criteria tested. Whereas an EHR Module certification means that the product meets at least one of the 33 criteria tested.



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
